Walk

Why not walk to the EMRC if you live or work close enough? Walking along the Swan River offers a stress free option for getting to and from the EMRC.


Cycle

Replacing your car trips by riding a bicycle is a great way to be active. You can choose convenient and safe routes for cycling using the area map opposite, your Local TravelSmart Guide¹ or Perth Bike Map².

Staff: Bicycle parking is provided inside the shed at the rear entry of the building (PIN code access) with shower facilities nearby.

Visitors: Bicycle parking is located on the right hand side of the building (tall decorative posts).





Public transport

There are four bus stops less than 500m walk from the EMRC. Frequent bus services run along Great Eastern Highway (routes 36, 40, 295, 296, 299) and the Circle Route (routes 98 and 99) run every 15 minutes during the day from Bayswater and Oats Street Train Stations.

Carpool and car

Find a colleague and share a ride to the EMRC. If driving is your only option, you can access free parking at the front and side of the building, via Kalgoorlie Street. If travelling from an easterly direction, a U-turn must be performed at the Hardey Road intersection due to the median strip along Great Eastern Highway. On departure, a U-turn is permitted at the Epsom Avenue intersection to continue your journey west.

Disabled access

A parking bay for people with disabilities is located in front of the main entrance of the building. A lift is available to access reception located on the 1st floor.
