



INJURED WILDLIFE

Wildlife First Aid

1. Remove from danger - that is, pick the patient up and put it in a safe, quiet, secure place. A covered box or pillow case is ideal. Try to confine the animal to where it is warm, dark and quiet. Drop a box over it if feasible.
2. DON'T give the patient any food or water. Can be lethal.
3. Call your local wildlife carer IMMEDIATELY.

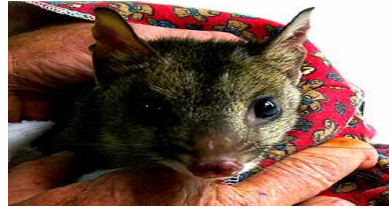
Raptor First Aid

- If you are able to approach the bird, there is something wrong
- Once the initial threat is removed call a wildlife carer
- Use cardboard box to contain raptor with air holes and a towel
- NEVER use wire cages to contain raptors
- Approach the bird quietly and throw a towel over it, then pin it down gently.
