2.	EMRC Update	Ambient monitoring has been completed – report is completed for noise and odour
	·	A noise issue has been identified with the power station. This matter has been taken up with Landfill gas and power
		The ambient monitoring will be extended for 2 month to allow for data to be gathered during the wet weather.
		Tenderers are being followed to up provide their emissions data. There has also been some delay getting a response from the EPA on the Environmental Scoping Document.
		Still aiming for the draft PER to go to the EPA by August but it is getting tighter. At the same time this happens the EMRC would organise a briefing of the CTF on the outcomes of the environmental impact assessment and we will consider providing the CTF with copies for comment.
		The EMRC is considering the merits of a design build and operate contract model.
		A presentation on anaerobic digestion has been scheduled for 24 <sup>th</sup> of June. If CTF members cannot attend they are able to come to the council briefing (but will not be able to ask questions here).
